What We Ask of You

- You will share stories of God's mission by showing videos produced by the synod, conduct the accompanying devotion, and share the ELCA resource Stories of Faith in Action in a variety of settings within the congregation.
- You will display the poster titled Where Does My Offering Go? in an appropriate place in your church facility
